Private usage of a purchase

How do we deal with our own use of a purchase, such as a car?

As a sole proprietorship, you may incur professional costs for a purchase that you also use for private purposes. For example, for a car, or energy costs for a space that is also used privately. These cost items may not be booked entirely as professional expenses.

Within Yoursminc we manage this using: a cost category, an example of a cost category could be 'Car costs', see the following worked example:

Navigate to the menu **Miscellaneous - Preferences - Cost categories** and from the cost category overview select 'CAR COSTS'
